Joshua's numerous accolades include the award for Best Performance of an Australian Work at the Lev Vlassenko Piano Competition, Second Prize at the Lev Vlassenko International Internet Piano Competition (Russia), and First Prizes at both the Global International Piano Competition (Shenzhen, China) and the XII International Rotary Children's Music Competition (Moscow, Russia). He was also honoured as a Showcase Artist at the 2023 Sydney International Piano Competition.
